What is urban wood? Lumber diverted from landfills - fallen due to insects, disease, weather damage or construction, never grown to be milled for furniture.

All of our wood is sourced within a 100-mile radius of Chicago. Hardwoods are durable and great for high traffic areas.




URBAN WALNUT



WHY CHOOSE WALNUT?

- Naturally dark in color with added interest due to the contrasting sapwood
- Large variety of live edge options due to tree shapes
- Trees grow large in diameter and are great for slab tables





URBAN ASH



WHY CHOOSE ASH?

- Ideal option for staining and ebonizing
- Many ash tress are dying due to the Emerald Ash bore making ash a cost effective raw material




URBAN ELM



WHY CHOOSE ELM?

- Often has dramatic knot and grain patterns
- Elm trees grow in unique shapes resulting in dramatic live edge
- Trees grow large in diameter and are great for slab tables






URBAN HICKORY



WHY CHOOSE HICKORY?

- One of the most dense hardwoods grown in the US
- Traditionally used for furniture
- Bold knot pattern
- Distinct difference between the heart and sap woods




URBAN MAPLE



WHY CHOOSE MAPLE?

- Naturally light in tone
- Beautiful color variations
- Deep figuring
- Occasional spalting adds a network of black lines which follow the grain



URBAN OAK



WHY CHOOSE OAK?

- Beautiful and consistent coloring
- Dense and tight graining
- Naturally rot resistant





BOOKMATCHED VS APPLIED LIVE EDGE

Live edge urban wood tables are a one-of-a-kind statement piece that have been made popular in offices as community, conference, counter and dining tables. But did you know we make two kinds of live edge tables?


BOOKMATCHED SLAB

- Consists of two consecutive cuts from the same tree, joined together to mirror each other
- Width of each slab ranges from 12"-20", larger slabs available upon request
- Typical length of slabs ranges from 8'-13'
- Restricted to width and length of slab

APPLIED LIVE EDGE

- Consists of multiple 6"-8" boards glued together
- Outside boards are live edge, custom selected for each table
- Customizable to virtually any dimensions
- Larger tables are often fabricated in multiple parts





COMMON BASE OPTIONS

Our bases are fabricated with hot rolled steel, wood or veneer. Custom base designs are available upon request.

All steel bases are finished with powdercoat and wood bases are finished with a commercial-grade water based finish.

COMMON MATERIALS

- HR steel flat bar, tube, or plate
- Wood post or dowel
- All bases are height adjustable and can accommodate power
- Casters available upon request


COMMON POWER OPTIONS




